### **ROMA'S EASTER IN THE COUNTRY 2024**

Thank you for choosing Roma as your destination for Easter and we welcome you with open arms to enjoy the bush experience and spending time meeting new friends. The Easter in the Country Committee has endeavoured to put a program together that will entertain and excite people of all ages. I would like to outline some matters which may be helpful to you for your stay in Roma.

#### **How do I know where to go?**

The festival program outlines a wide range of activities from Thursday – Monday. There is a printed copy at the entry to the Camp ground or an electronic copy can be found on the What's on Page of the website – [www.easterinthecountryroma.com.au](http://www.easterinthecountryroma.com.au). The weather forecast is for fine bright days. Please ensure that you carry your chair to all activities if you wish to be guaranteed seating because as you can see we are the bush and we do not have stadiums! You would be surprised how many requests I have had for seating in a stadium.

#### **Check-in process:**

Please select a site and a camping official will visit the grounds on Wednesday and Easter Thursday at 12 Midday, 2pm, 4pm and 6pm to ensure those who have booked are checked in.

On Friday 07/04/2023 an official will be onsite from 9am – 5pm – this person will provide an event program and check you in against the Try Booking spreadsheet.

The camp grounds are heavily booked so we ask that you think of others when siting your van/camp site and you take enough room to be comfortable but be considerate of others and their need for adequate space as well. We would like everyone to enjoy the benefits of the wide-open spaces.

#### **Requirements while in the Bungil Street Roma:**

- Ensure that you are respectful to each camper. If an issue arises, please direct this issue to 0459521196 or to Brett and Liz and the matter will be dealt with quickly.
- Cleaning of facilities – there will be a fulltime person on duty for this. The facilities are temporary showers and toilets
- Pets are allowed on a lead and remember to clean up after them. No pets are allowed at horse sports including the Xtreme Bulls and XXXX Rodeo or car sports.

**Fire Pits:** Fire Pits are permitted and MUST be fully supervised. All pits are required to be extinguished after use. There will be an area marked for the disposal of any ashes and please ensure this is used.

**Rubbish:** There will be numerous wheelie bins as well as a number of skip bins which will be emptied during the week/weekend. All rubbish needs to be placed in the bins. Please leave your camp site as you find it. All rubbish from wheelie bins will be removed on Friday and Monday

**Emergency Medical Attention:** If there is a need to call an Ambulance please call 000. At the same time a person from your site or a neighbour needs to go to the entry gate and wait for the ambulance so someone can show them where to go. The camp ground is only temporary so not set up with site numbers and to assist the ambulance to find where the emergency is there is a requirement for direction. Please ensure you are aware of this.

**Noise Control:** While this is a weekend of fun and festival please ensure you have respect for others in managing the noise component of your “partying”.

**Security:** All services are working together for the festival and the Queensland Police are aware of the camping capacity etc and will be doing drive through patrols over the weekend. Please ensure all camp sites are secure when leaving them. Roma Security will provide drive through security services each night every hour to ensure your safety.

**Non-powered sites:** Two power points have been established for phone charging. These points are near the sheep stalls so please feel free to utilise them.

**Powered sites:** Please ensure that you have a 15 amp adaptor as all power points are 10 amp.

Thank you for taking the time to read this and we wish you the best time ever at our little festival and we hope you enjoy the beautiful countryside which has turned out it very best after recent rain.
